ROBBERY SUSPECT SOUGHT

ELK GROVE, CA – On February 27, 2010 at 7:15 p.m., the Elk Grove Police Department responded to a robbery that had taken place in the parking lot of Kohl's (9650 Bruceville Road).

An unidentified male approached a female customer as she was walking from her parked vehicle towards the front entrance of the store. The suspect forcibly grabbed the customer's purse and fled on foot. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male in his mid to late twenties (20's), approx. five feet ten inches tall (5'10"), with a thin build and a goatee with a thin beard connected to his sideburns.

Through investigative efforts, detectives were able to identify the individual responsible for the robbery as 25-year-old Sacramento resident Jose Luis Mora-Ortiz (02/28/1985). Detectives have obtained a warrant for the arrest of Mora-Ortiz (photo below), who may have fled to Mexico.
