BANK ROBBERY SUSPECT SOUGHT

ELK GROVE, CA – The Elk Grove Police Department is asking for the community's help in identifying a suspect involved in a bank robbery that took place on March 29, 2010 at the U.S. Bank located at 5000 Laguna Boulevard.

At approximately 9:03 a.m., the suspect pictured below approached a teller and displayed a black handgun then demanded money. The teller complied and handed the suspect an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency. The subject placed the money inside a black bag then exited the location on foot. It is unknown what method of transportation was utilized by the suspect as he fled the area.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male, approximately fifty years of age, five feet six inches tall (5'6"), one hundred seventy pounds (170 lbs.). The suspect was described as having salt and pepper hair (possibly a wig), round glasses, a black mustache, wearing a charcoal colored sport jacket, maroon shirt, blue jeans with a black leather belt and black gloves.
