### **ATTEMPTED ROBBERY SUSPECT SOUGHT**

ELK GROVE, CA – The Elk Grove Police Department is asking for the community's help in identifying a suspect involved in an attempted robbery that took place on November 19, 2010 at Walmart located at 8465 Elk Grove Boulevard.

At approximately 8:56 p.m., an unidentified male (photo below) entered Walmart and approached the customer service counter. The suspect handed an employee a note indicating that this was a robbery. The suspect then displayed a small chrome handgun in a threatening manner when another employee approached. Several customers saw what was taking place and ran from the customer service counter area.

As a result of the disturbance created by the customers fleeing the area, the armed suspect left the store on foot without any money. The suspect possibly fled in a silver or tan 2002-2003 Honda Civic four-door sedan with tinted rear windows.

The suspect was described as a Caucasian male, approximately twenty to thirty years of age, five feet eight inches tall (5'8") with a thin build. The suspect had sandy blond hair and was unshaven. The suspect was last seen wearing a red baseball cap, gray hooded sweatshirt, faded blue jeans and dark shoes.
