ROBBERY SUSPECTS ARRESTED AFTER PURSUIT

ELK GROVE, CA – On September 12, 2011 at 10:20 p.m., the Elk Grove Police Department received a call regarding an armed robbery that had just taken place in the 9500 block of Surritt Way.

The victim indicated that he had just pulled into his driveway when he was confronted by two Asian males. One of the men brandished a firearm and demanded the victim's gold chain. The armed suspect then grabbed the gold chain from around the victim's neck, and both suspects ran to an awaiting vehicle driven by a third person.

The three suspects then sped away from the location in a blue two-door Honda Accord. The victim drove after the suspects and called 911 to advise law enforcement of the robbery. Responding officers were able to catch up to the suspect vehicle that was still being followed by the victim. The victim stopped following when officers arrived. Officers driving fully marked police vehicles activated their emergency lights and sirens in an attempt to conduct an enforcement stop of the suspect vehicle. The driver of the Honda Accord did not yield and led officers on a seven mile pursuit.

During the pursuit, allied law enforcement agencies responded to assist. AIR 21, a California Highway Patrol air unit, joined officers in the pursuit as it traversed city streets and Highway 99. When the suspect vehicle began travelling on Calvine Rd., officers utilized the Pursuit Intervention Technique (PIT), which is a low speed maneuver designed to cause the suspect vehicle to spin out thus ending the pursuit. The driver of the Honda, 23-year-old Sarom Kuy (Sacramento resident), was unable to control the vehicle and collided with a residence. Two of the three occupants ran from the vehicle after the collision. Officers immediately detained the Sarom Kuy at the scene of the collision.

Officers chased after the other two suspects who fled on foot. Officers located 27-year-old Nary Chap (Sacramento resident) with the assistance of AIR 21 in a nearby field. Chap was detained by a police K-9 after fighting with officers. Officers located 22-year-old Kally Sam (Sacramento resident) hiding under a wheelbarrow in a residential area. After a brief struggle, Sam was detained by a police K-9 and additional officers.

Officers were able to recover the property that had been taken in the robbery; however, the weapon was not located. The three suspects were arrested and booked into the Sacramento County Main Jail on Robbery and Conspiracy charges.
