### TRAFFIC ADVISORY FOR DEPUTY LARRY CANFIELD'S MEMORIAL SERVICES

On Thursday, November 20, 2008, at 10:00 a.m., memorial services for Sacramento County Sheriff's Deputy Larry Canfield will be held at the First Baptist Church of Elk Grove which is located at 8939 East Stockton Boulevard, Elk Grove. Following the memorial service, a law enforcement procession will escort Deputy Canfield's family to the Galt Arno Cemetery, located at 14180 Joy Drive in Galt.

Motorists should expect the following:

#### In the Elk Grove Area

- Beginning at 6:00 a.m., electronic reader boards will be in place on Highway 99 (North/South) advising of traffic delays and advising those attending the service to exit at Laguna Boulevard.
- East Stockton Boulevard between Sheldon Road and the area just south of East Lawn will be closed from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Sheldon Road between Lewis Stein Road and the on ramp to southbound Highway 99 will be closed from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Electronic reader boards will be in place to notify motorists of the delays and road closures.
- Local businesses in the immediate area of the road closures will be open for business, and traffic heading to the businesses will not be affected.

#### On Highway 99 between Elk Grove and Galt

- Beginning at approximately 12:30 p.m., when the law enforcement procession leaves the church, the California Highway Patrol will conduct rolling traffic breaks and intermittent ramp closures on southbound Highway 99 between Sheldon Road and Liberty Road.

#### In the Galt Area

- Joy Road will be closed from H Street to Kost Road from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Kost Road will be closed from Lincoln Way to Raven Brook Drive from 12:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Lincoln Way will be closed from Kost Road to Cornell Road from 12:00p.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Expect delays in central Galt due to heavy traffic. All other street closures will be temporary during the procession.

Those traveling in the Elk Grove and Galt areas on Thursday should anticipate day-long delays and heavy traffic congestion and should seek alternative routes.
