Santa & Sirens Parades Return to Elk Grove Neighborhoods, December 9-11

Elk Grove, Calif. – The Cosumnes Community Services District (CSD) Fire Department and the Elk Grove Police Department will coordinate the annual Santa & Sirens neighborhood parades, December 9-11. Parades are scheduled in the following neighborhoods:

- **Laguna Creek**, December 9
- **Central Elk Grove**, December 10 and
- **Elk Grove/West Vineyard**, December 11

Parades start and end at the nearest CSD fire station -- traveling the neighborhoods from 7-9 p.m. each night, weather permitting.

A small convoy of antique and modern emergency vehicles decked out for the holidays will escort Santa, Mrs. Claus, and his holiday entourage through the streets of Elk Grove. Firefighters, police officers, and volunteers will hand out candy canes and spread holiday cheer to residents of all ages. Donations of new, unwrapped toys for the Police/Fire Holiday Toy Drive will also be accepted along the route.

“This is a great way for us to thank our community for their support, spreading holiday cheer, and collecting donated toys for boys and girls whose families are unable to afford them this Christmas,” said Fire Chief Steve Foster.
