ELK GROVE PD TO CONDUCT SOBRIETY CHECKPOINT

ELK GROVE, CA – The Elk Grove Police Department will be conducting a sobriety and drivers license checkpoint within the city of Elk Grove on February 13, 2010 beginning at approximately 8:00 p.m.

The checkpoint will focus on removing impaired drivers, as well as unlicensed drivers from the roadways. Educational materials covering the dangers of driving under the influence will also be handed out to motorists. Funding for the sobriety checkpoint is provided through a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Grant that was made available by the California Office of Traffic Safety through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
