The Elk Grove Police Department Volunteers are a team of trained citizen volunteers who assist officers and administrative staff with non-enforcement duties and value added services that allow officers to focus on crime reduction.

Members do not take enforcement action, carry weapons, or make arrests.

Elk Grove Police volunteers will receive training in the following:

- Orientation and Organization
- Basic Report Writing
- Radio Communications
- Introduction to Missing Persons
- Traffic Control and Safety Procedures
- Finger printing

Volunteers also complete one ride-along with a Patrol Officer and a sit along with a dispatcher as part of the training program.

- Attend three days of training
- Meet the required qualifications for the volunteer assignment/position
- Wear approved uniform and present a professional appearance
- Comply with confidentiality requirements and policies governing police operations
- Maintain a positive and supportive attitude
- Ability to work with people of all background
