

Purchase of Assault Weapons by Sworn Personnel

313.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This policy is to follow existing laws and establish procedural guidelines regarding the purchase of assault weapons by individual sworn peace officers of the Elk Grove Police Department.

313.2 POLICY

It shall be the policy of the Elk Grove Police Department to authorize the purchase of assault weapons by sworn personnel in good standing, in accordance to California Penal Code section 12280, subsections (f)(1), (f)(2) and (g)(2). Individual sworn officers as defined under 830.1(a) PC who are interested in purchasing and assault weapon for official duties or for personal use must comply with this procedure before and upon acquiring an assault weapon.

313.3 DEFINITIONS

Assault Weapon: any weapon as defined under sections 12276 and 12276.1 of the California Penal Code

Exemptions: granting of exception to the typical requirement

Peace Officer: Any person who meets the provisions of 830 of the California Penal Code and who otherwise meets all standards imposed by law on a peace officer and is a peace officer for a bona fide law enforcement agency.
